
#### **MEDLEY OF ACTIVITIES**




#### WOMEN'S DAY

#### TEACHER'S DAY



#### CHRISTMAS












#### OLYMPIAD RESULTS (IEO)


"The harder you work for something, the greater you will feel when you achieve it and there is no magic to achievement, it is really about hard work and choices."
